Myrtle Beach FAQ 2025



What are the dates for the Myrtle Beach trip?

The trip will be held April 13-19, 2025. Sunday, April 13th there is a family and player dinner. All events will be completed by Friday night.

How many games, scrimmages and practices will there be? And where will they be located?

3 games and 3 scrimmages will be played at:

Ripken, Myrtle Beach: 3051 Ripken Way, Myrtle Beach, SC 29577

Schedule will be posted as soon as possible. Coach Murphy has requested that a game and scrimmage will be played on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, but nothing is finalized.

Where will players be staying?

Royal Garden Resort, 1210 N Waccamaw Drive, Murrells Inlet, SC. Multiple players will share and be assigned condos. These condos include kitchens and laundry machines.

Where will families be staying?

Families will be given the option to book at the same resort, Royal Garden Resort. We have one and two bedroom condos set aside for a Fairport Baseball block for family booking. Cost per night is approximately \$200. Our contact is Logan Donaldson with Sea Breeze Realty. Approximately a \$200 deposit will be due at time of booking.

What is the approximate cost per player?

Cost will be approximately \$300 per player, dependent upon how many players are on the team. This cost will be finalized after player selection and following the Youth Clinic. For the second year, we will be utilizing our Youth Clinic profit to lower player costs. Payment will be due within a few days of player selection

What is covered in the cost per player?

Room and tournament fee are both included in the cost for players.

What is NOT covered in the cost per player?

All food, paper goods and extracurricular activities are not included in player cost. Families are responsible for providing these items for player rooms and covering any optional extra curricular events. Once room assignments are made, the players and families can coordinate who will be bringing what food and supplies. There is a Walmart and Food Lion just a few short minutes from the Royal Garden Resort.

Will there be any other team events?

Families and players will attend an opening night pizza party. Pizza party is included in player cost. There will likely be another optional family and player dinner.

How will players get to and from Myrtle Beach?

Players will be driven by parents to Myrtle Beach.

How will players get to and from Myrtle Beach events (ie. games, scrimmages, etc.)?

Parents will provide all transportation for players while in Myrtle Beach.

Can my player drive during the Myrtle Beach "field trip"?

Players will NOT be permitted to drive while in Myrtle Beach since this is considered a school field trip.

My family can't attend the trip. How will my player get there and around while in Myrtle Beach?

Other player parents will be assigned to drive students while in MB if families are unable to attend. If this is a need for your family, please connect with us after player selection. FCSD has a process we will adhere to for "field trip chaperones" to be drivers. More information to come.

Can I drive players other than my son to and from games and scrimmages?

Yes, that will be possible. Players' parents will be requested to register as drivers. The process for being a registered driver will include a background check by law enforcement. These details will be covered at the Myrtle Beach meeting.

We can't afford the cost for my player to attend. Is there anything that can be done?

If a player is dealing with financial hardship, please connect with Coach Murphy after player selection. There is a Varsity Club that provides assistance for players in need on a case-by-case basis. This whole process will remain confidential.
